Dear Madam,

as you may be aware, our organisation, the Refugee Facilities Administration of the Ministry of Interior, is established to operate facilities for asylum seekers (based on act on asylum Nr. 325/1999 Coll.) and detention facilities for foreigners who are subject of administrative expulsion (based on act on residence of foreigners on the territory of the Czech Republic Nr. 326/1999 Coll.) and provide services in those facilities. So as regards minors (including unaccompanied), we may provide only numbers that cover asylum facilities and detention centres mentioned above.

For information about minors in juvenile offender facilities, I recommend you to address Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports (www.msmt.cz [1]; e-mail: posta@msmt.cz [2])

For information about minors in court detention, I recommend you to address Ministry of Justice (portal.justice.cz/Justice2/ms/ms.asp [3]; e-mail: posta@msp.justice.cz [4])

as these two types of facilities have nothing in common with our activities. To answer to your request for information under the Law on free Access to Information, 106/1999 Dated 11 May 1999 I am sending you following information:

1) Minors (under 18) in Reception centers:

- * 2010 - 157 minors (included 6 unaccompanied)
- * 2011 - 89 minors (included 3 unaccompanied)
- * 2012 - 115 minors (included 8 unaccompanied)

2) Minors in Detention centers:

- * 2010 - 40 minors (included 3 unaccompanied)
- * 2011 - 7 minors (none unaccompanied)
- * 2012 - 11 minors (none unaccompanied)
