

Department of Risk Analysis and Coordination of the Bureau of Border and Alien Police Presidium of the Police Force are sending you on your request regarding immigration related detention following documents:

1. Please provide a complete list of the names and locations of all the facilities that currently are in use for the purpose of confining non-citizens in administrative detention for periods exceeding three days because of immigration-related reasons.

2. Please provide the total number of people detained for immigration-related reasons during the years 2010, 2011, and 2012.

In the Police Detention Centers for Aliens in Sečovce and Medveďov were placed third country nationals under the relevant provisions of the Aliens Act in years 2010, 2011, 2012 (to 31.12.2011 Act. 48/2002 col. as amended and from 01.01.2012 Act. 404/2011 col.). In these totals are included third country nationals who were detained for the purpose of administrative expulsion, the purpose of execution of the sentence of expulsion, transfer under the Dublin regulation, for the purpose of refoulement under international treaty. If they applied for asylum in Slovakia during their placement, the detention of these persons continued after the acceptance of application for asylum in the Slovak Republic, so this fact was not a reason for their release.

3. Please provide the total number of asylum seekers who were placed in detention during the years 2010, 2011, and 2012.

People who applied for asylum in the Slovak Republic before detention were not detained and placed to detention centers for aliens in 2010 – 2012 (they were transported or sent to not secured reception centers of Migration Office of the Ministry of Interior of the Slovak Republic).

The total number in the table below includes the number of persons who applied for asylum after their placement in detention centers or the number of persons who were detained for the purpose of transfer under the Dublin regulation, so for the purpose of their return to member state responsible for processing of their asylum application.

PDCA Sečovce is the only one such facility in Slovakia where it is possible to place families with minors or accompanied minors detained under the provisions of the Aliens Act.

2) Please provide the total number of people detained for immigration-related reasons during the years 2010, 2011, and 2012.ⁱⁱ


3) Please provide the total number of asylum seekers who were placed in detention during the years 2010, 2011, and 2012.ⁱⁱⁱ

ⁱ The list should include any facility where an individual is prevented from freely leaving the facility at his or her will. In addition to long-term detention facilities used for the purposes of facilitating deportation (including both criminal prisons and specially designed immigration detention centers), this list should include any "reception centers" that prevent asylum seekers from freely exiting the premises; any shelters or juvenile centers that deprive minors, including both accompanied and unaccompanied minors, of their liberty; as well as any transit facilities or border guard stations located in airports or other ports of entry into the country that can hold people for more than three days to prevent entry into the country.

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
